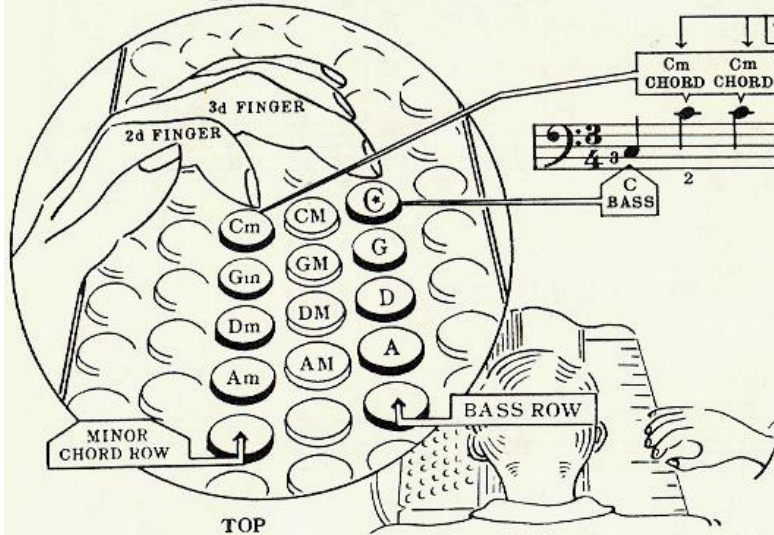


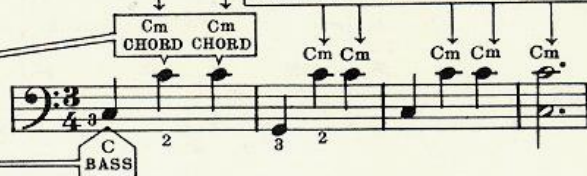



Eighth Notes

EIGHTH NOTES carry a flag like this:  or  or 

Two EIGHTH NOTES equal a QUARTER NOTE in time value.  = 

In $\frac{2}{4}$, $\frac{3}{4}$ or $\frac{4}{4}$ Time a QUARTER NOTE receives 1 Count.

An EIGHTH therefore will receive $\frac{1}{2}$ Count.
